1. YEAR 2020 ACCIDENT DATA


The decreased trend of road accident continued during December month as well, though fatality has increased slightly by 1.7%, and the decrease in accident is not as intense as in previous few months. Impact of COVID-19 on traffic movement pattern and accident data is no more visible during the month of December 2020. Table showing the comparative analysis of road accident during the month of December is shown below:

2. ACCIDENT REPORTED IN YEAR 2020

The accident statistics reported by SCRB for the year 2020, marked considerable reduction in road crashes and related fatalities. In actual figures, around 13,149 less road accidents and 1,488 less fatalities are reported in this year, compared to 2019. District-wise as well as Month-wise comparative analysis of road accident of year 2020 is carried out. Table showing the comparative analysis of road accidents is shown below:


With the implementation of Amended Motor Vehicle Act, and fully fledged deployment of Safe Kerala Squad and together with various other supportive road safety measures; from

the last quarter of year 2019 onwards a considerable reduction in road crashes and especially road fatalities is observed. The reduced trend in road accident fatalities continued during first quarter of 2020. COVID-19 Lockdown and Unlock period also tremendously supported the course. 4. QUARTERLY ACCIDENT ANALYSIS

The first quarter of 2020 was mostly a regular period without the influence of COVID-19 related travel impacts. Almost two months of the second quarter was COVID-19 Lockdown period, which marked a great improvement in curtailing road accidents and fatalities. Last

month of second quarter was during COVID-19 Unlock phase. Third quarter was fully within COVID-19 Unlock phases, with widely varying travelling pattern and traffic modes. During third quarter, commuters and long trips had shown a shift in travel mode from public transport to private modes. This trend continued during Quarter four with COVID-19 Unlock protocols. The fourth quarter also showed reduction in road accidents in comparison with similar period in 2019. Tables below shows the quarterly comparison of accident data reported in four quarters of 2020:

5. COVID-19 IMPACT ON ROAD ACCIDENTS

During phase 1 & 2 of COVID-19 lockdown almost all modes of transportation including public transport and personal vehicle trips were restricted. Most offices and commercial endeavors remained closed during this period. Many offices adopted 'Work from Home' strategy which helps avoiding many trips. Essential and emergency travels were allowed during Phase 3. The Phase 4 saw gradual relaxations in private vehicle trips and many offices started functioning with limited staffs. Opening of commercial shops with time control also attracted day time traffic.

As per the data reported by State Crime Records Bureau (SCRB), during the first three months of year 2020, even before the lockdown saw a reduction 14% in road fatality, even though the accidents reported has increased marginally by 1%, compare to corresponding period of previous year. With various efforts in improving road safety in the State and enrolling of Safe Kerala Project made significant progress towards achieving road safety targets in the first quarter of 2020. Complimenting to the good work in upholding State's road safety goals, the restriction in vehicular traffic as well as walk trips during COVID-19 lockdown period helped in containing the upward accident trend & curtailing road fatalities.

The State Crime Records Bureau (SCRB) has forwarded the accident data reported during various phases of COVID-19 lockdown and corresponding period during previous year. The accident data provided by SCRB is tabulated and presented in below Tables.

6. LIFE SAVED DURING DECADE OF ACTION

India being a signatory in Brasilia Declaration is committed to the UN's Decade of Action for Road Safety 2011-2020. Kerala playing the part, the target estimated for the State as per Decade of Action calculations is to save 14,814 Lives during the decade. The average annual growth rate of road fatalities during the decade (2011-2020) worldwide estimated by UN as approximately 4.4%. With decade action plan, around -3.2% targeted road fatality reduction across the world was planned to save 5 million lives across the world.




Figure 3: Performance of Kerala in Decade of Action - period (2011 to 2020)

Above graph shows the performance of Kerala in reducing road fatality during Decade of Action period (2011 to 2020). Kerala achieved 65% of the target by saving 9681 lives. Table below shows the year wise Decade Action Plan target and the performance of Kerala State in achieving the decade of action fatality reduction.

With considerable reduction in road accidents and fatality during 2020, Kerala has achieved the yearly target.

7. SUMMARY

During December 2020, the pattern of road accident reduction witnessed in last few months continued with a total of 581 fewer accidents. But road fatalities had gone up slightly by losing 6 more lives this month than corresponding period in previous year. Overall road safety performance of State during the year 2020 was remarkable by saving 1488 lives on road and with 13149 less number of accidents, compared to previous year. This helped the State in overall reduction of 32% in road accidents and 33.5% in road fatalities in year 2020.
